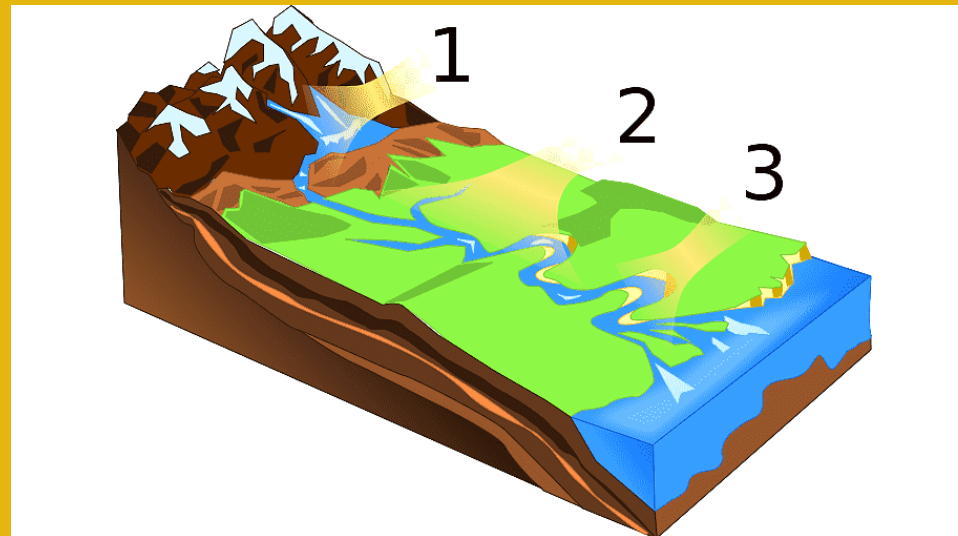

# S tages of a river

- Sorting through different categories of knowledge
- Recognising different perspectives and environments



# S tages of a river

- Connecting academic language to concepts
- Respectfully consider answers given by all
- Consider the implications of climate changes to people dependent on specific rivers

# S tages of a river



**When would living near a river be an advantage and when would it be a disadvantage? Include economic and social considerations in your answers.**

- Appreciating the connection between the environment and an individual's and a society's well-being
- Using interdisciplinary phenomena to evaluate advantages.



# S tages of a river



**What would be a reason for diverting a river?  
Include the community, labor force, environmental  
impact and health in your answers.**

- Applying facts to social and environmental concerns



# S tages of a river



**Why would using rivers to mark borders between countries be a sound idea? Would it depend on the characteristics of the river?**

- Embedding sophisticated vocabulary in questions to augment long-term language assimilation
- Encouraging students to consider subjects on a larger scale. Citing facts in order to justify answers.

**What if an immigrant community needed to relocate. Would the most sustainable area be the upper, middle or lower course of a river.**

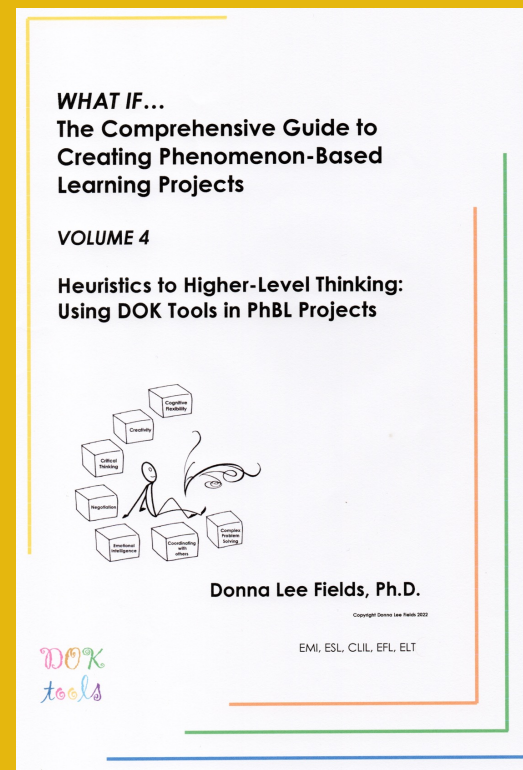
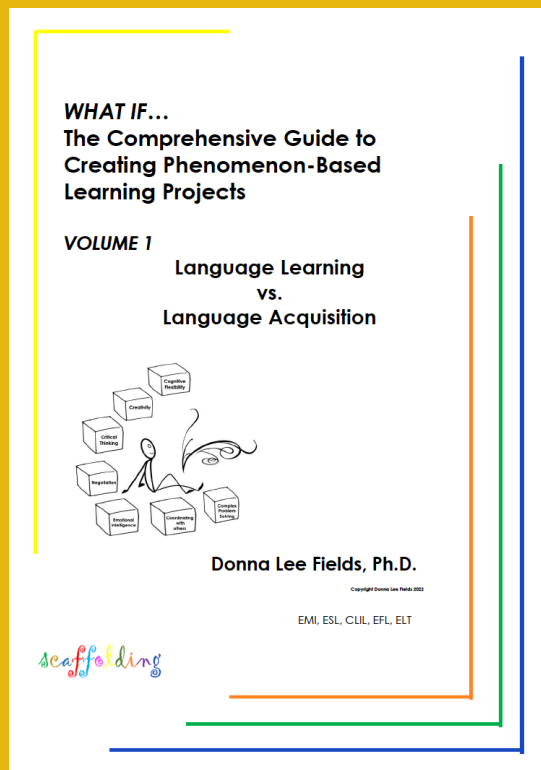
**What would be most advantageous way of harmoniously incorporating them into the existing community? Include the characteristics of the immigrants in your answer.**

- Comparing conflicting elements of societies
- Studying the characteristics of a specific group of people and exploring their best interests
- Considering the needs of creating a harmonious heterogeneous community
